

## Virtual World Finals Spontaneous Problem

1. Make sure all team members are in communication with one another— one team member will access and complete the Competition Response Form for the entire team. This is the ONLY person who will see the timer.
2. Make sure each team member has a pencil and paper to record ideas. Team members should write down ideas and give the best ones.
3. This is a verbal problem where your team will give 25 responses.
4. There are five scoring value choices: 5 or 10 points, 4 or 8 points, 3 or 6 points, 2 or 4 points, and 1 or 2 points.
5. There are 5 entries for every scoring value (5 responses x 5 scoring values = 25 responses).
6. Each response will be scored as common or creative. Common responses will receive the lower value and creative responses will receive the higher value.
7. If you believe your response is highly creative, enter under a higher value. If you think your response is less creative, you should choose a field with a lower value. For example, if you type a response in the 4/8 field, the judge will give you 4 points if your response is common, and 8 points if it is creative.
8. There is only one response per entry field.
9. Each response should be different from the rest.
10. The person who is logged into the Competition Response Form will type all the responses given by the team members in the scoring field of their choice. An email with the link will be sent to the team contact in the Virtual World Finals Registration. The typist does not have to be a team member.
11. When you open the link, it will take you to the Spontaneous Welcome. There is a button to click on to start the process.
12. You may type in responses for any value at any time as directed by the team member giving that response.
13. Be careful, you must submit the form with the responses before time ends. You are finished when you hit submit or when time ends. You can only hit submit one time and you cannot access the form again.
14. You have 25 minutes to think of responses, pick your best five, and give them to the person who will type them in the scoring fields.
